Pursuant to the City of Chicago Municipal Code Section 4-60-040 (h), the City of Chicago Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection (BACP) and the above named Licensee have agreed to the issuance of a Consumption on Premises – Incidental Activity liquor license, under the following conditions:

- The licensee shall operate as a restaurant where the primary business activity will be the sale and service of food and where the sale of alcoholic beverages will only be incidental to the food service. The Licensee shall not operate in a manner where the sale of alcoholic beverages is the primary business activity.
- 2. Licensee shall only sever the following alcoholic beverages, Beer, Wine and Frozen Freezes with either vodka, tequila or rum.
- 3. Licensee shall regularly monitor the exterior area around the premises during all of its business hours in order to address and abate noise, loitering and littering complaints about Licensee's patrons or employees.
- 4. The Licensee will cease the sale of alcoholic beverages at 10pm on Sunday through Thursday, and at 12am (Midnight), Friday and Saturday.
- 5. The Licensee shall have a Security Guard on the premises from 9 pm 12 am on Thursday through Sunday.



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- 6. Alcohol Server Training. All restaurant staff will be BASSET or TIPS certified, and will be trained with respect to the detection of fraudulent identification. All restaurant staff will be trained to identify intoxicated patrons and will take pro-active steps to prevent the intoxication of patrons.
- 7. Kitchen to remain open. During all hours that the business is open to the public, the licensee shall offer food preparation and service to its patrons.
- 8. Non-Smoking Laws. The Licensee will enforce all applicable City and State nonsmoking laws as they relate to both the interior and the exterior of the Premises.
- 9. Licensee will post a sign on the interior of the door to the restaurant that states,

"Please be advised that pursuant to State and City law no customer may leave Taco Bell with an **Alcoholic Beverage**, Beer, Wine or Freeze. Please dispose of any unused portion of your alcoholic beverage prior to leaving the restaurant. Thank you for your cooperation and for visiting us."

10. This Plan of Operation will be reviewed by the Alderman and Licensee nine months after the date of issuance of the Consumption on Premises Incidental Activity License.

The conditions of the liquor license issued pursuant to this plan of operation are legally binding and may be enforced by the City of Chicago enforcement authorities under Section 4-60-040 (h) of the City of Chicago Municipal Code. All other conditions of the license are governed by the City of Chicago Municipal Code. Violation of the above stated conditions may result in the imposition of a fine and/or suspension or revocation of all business licenses issued to the Licensee. Violation of the above stated conditions may also result in the issuance of Cease and Desist Orders prohibiting the activity which violates the conditions of the liquor license.

The conditions of the liquor license issued pursuant to this plan of operation shall apply to the business address and License and to all officers, managers, partners, and direct or indirect owners of the licensed entity. The sale of the business to other persons purchasing the stock or membership units of the licensed entity does not void the conditions of the license. Any and all potential new owners of the licensed entity shall be subject to the same conditions set forth in this plan of operation.
