Re: 2293 N. Milwaukee Ave. – Pedestrian Protection Canopy
Date: January 19, 2015

Per our email to you last week, we will be installing a pedestrian protection canopy on the N. Milwaukee Ave. sidewalk. This canopy is required by the City of Chicago as part of our general construction logistics plan.

Installation will begin on Wednesday, January 20th and require approximately five days to complete. Beginning at the corner of N. Milwaukee Ave. and N. Washtenaw Ave. and progressing northwest to W. Belden Ave., installation will be staged from a flatbed truck utilizing the N. Milwaukee Ave. parking lane. The canopy will consist of two sections, each approximately 159' lineal feet. Generally, no canopy will be erected between the two buildings currently under construction.

The subcontractor installing the canopy has been informed about the importance of maintaining access to the bike lane. While installation is occurring, pedestrians may be directed to cross the street.

In response to your question, we will not be using concrete "Jersey" barriers which were installed for 2211 N. Milwaukee Ave. project. Our protection canopy will be installed on and cover a portion of the existing sidewalk. The canopy is constructed of metal framing with a "roof" comprised of either wood or metal to which "interior" lighting will be attached to illuminate the covered sidewalk. It will also include a 4.0' wood parapet along the entire length of each canopy structure (required by the city).

The canopy permit is attached. Please note that the permit is effectively through January 28, 2016 at which time it will be renewed.

Restrictions:

1. A copy of the permit must remain on-site for inspector's review.
2. Storage of material or equipment WILL NOT be allowed on the Canopy unless a letter is submitted to the Public-Way Permit Office from a State of Illinois licensed structural engineer stating that the vaulted sidewalk can structurally support the weight of the Canopy and materials/equipment.
3. Pedestrian walkway must be kept free of all obstructions and debris.
4. Sight clearance of all traffic signals and regulatory signs must be maintained at all times.
5. Maintain fire hydrant and manhole access.
6. Construction and maintenance of permitted canopy must be in conformity with all pertinent provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago and the Chicago Department of Transportation Regulations for Openings, Construction, and Repair in the Public Way including, but not limited to, provisions pertaining to accessibility requirements for persons with disabilities.
